Songwriting

Everyone has their own reason for writing a song – or wanting to – but how do you get started? And once you've started, how can you tell if what you've come up with is any good? How can you improve it?

One of the best ways of finding new ways forward is to share your problems, find out how others have solved them, and learn from the ideas and experience of someone who listens with fresh, non-judgemental ears.

The course will include individual attention to your particular aims and ambitions, in whatever style you have chosen to work, as well as setting you tasks that maybe you hadn't even thought of. There'll be a chance to record the songs as part of the writing process and to work collaboratively. Being able to read and write music isn't necessary. Come and spend time finding the fulfilment that's possible when you put words and music together.

Pete Atkin has been writing songs all his life, sometimes on his own, and sometimes in collaboration (perhaps most famously with Clive James as lyricist) – songs for others and for himself to sing and record, songs for kids (*Play Away*) and songs for the theatre, for television and radio.

He is well-used to finding his own answers to all those awkward questions; answers which he is happy to share and explore.
